You will find all the information that you need about the Federation and all that it has to offer.

Your Federation

The Midland Counties Photographic Federation (MCPF): is one of fifteen Federations which comprise the Photographic Alliance of Great Britain (PAGB), the member clubs of these Federations are automatically affiliated to the Photographic Alliance. For more details about the PAGB please see their website <http://thepagb.org.uk/>

Organisation: the business of the MCPF is conducted by a Council which meets several times each year. A list of officers and Council members is included in this Guide and Directory.

Aims: the chief aim is to assist clubs to provide an adequate programme of instruction for their members through judges and lecturers. Members of Council are willing to help in any way possible when invited to do so.

National and Virtual (Internet) Clubs: National and Virtual (Internet) organisations that become members of the MCPF must undertake to use only work by those of their members who are resident in the MCPF area in competitions organised by the MCPF.

Subscriptions: are payable to the Federation by Clubs and are due 1st January.

Club information: to make sure that your clubs receives information from your Federation it is important that changes to your club contact details are kept up to date. At the beginning of each year we send secretaries the annual return detailing the information we currently have and ask for this to be checked and corrected where changes have taken place. Whilst this will continue, updates can now also be done on line via the Federation website at any time during the year ensuring information is sent to the correct officers of your club. Details and information on how to make the changes are also on the website.

General Meetings: can be held at venues throughout the Federation area by invitation of the member clubs. All club members are eligible to attend but only delegates may vote. (see MCPF rules for information about delegates).

Judges: are available for all types of exhibitions, competitions etcetera. They are entitled to out-of-pocket expenses as set out in the PAGB guide which should be paid to them at the time of the visit. Expenses should be agreed beforehand.

Lecturers: listed in this handbook are available to visit member clubs. They are entitled to out-of-pocket expenses as set out in the PAGB guide, which should be paid to them at the time of the visit. Expenses should be agreed beforehand.

Competitions and Exhibitions: Competitions are organised annually by the Federation and include:
Midphot Exhibition of Midland Photography: the exhibition is held in March, except for A/V and Print Panels which have their selections in January and October respectively, and enables individuals, through their clubs, to enter prints, creative panels of prints, projected digital images (PDI) and audio visuals.

Photofolio: is a competition between clubs. Acceptances into the exhibition form the basis of the circulating Portfolio of prints and PDI which is available to clubs on a pre-arranged circuit. The exhibition is held in June each year.

Print and PDI Championships: held each April, to identify the MCPF representatives to the PAGB Club Championships.

Midland Salon: an international exhibition of Prints and PDI's which will be held each year.

Exhibition Scoring: A scoring machine may be obtained on free loan (subject to availability) by member Clubs by arrangement with Roger or Judith Parry. Clubs are responsible for the cost of any physical damage but the Federation will correct any electronic failure.

Communication and Information: before each General Meeting clubs are circulated with all relevant information and occasionally there are extra postings. These postings will be made by email to club secretaries/delegates (where appropriate) or nominated other member where said person has no email.

Newsletter: an electronic newsletter is published monthly or when news becomes available and is sent to Club Secretaries via email. The Editor welcomes items of news and forthcoming events from clubs or individuals.

Seminars and Workshops: are organised annually and alternate between Judges Workshop and General Seminar.

Website: the MCPF has its own website with information about all of the above, plus galleries of images from the exhibitions www.mcpf.co.uk There is also space for clubs to advertise their own events. to send information to the webmaster email webmaster@mcpf.co.uk



Rules of the Midland Counties Photographic Federation

1. The Midland Counties Photographic Federation shall be open to all Photographic Societies and Photographic Sections of scientific and other societies in the Midland Counties and for the purpose of this Federation, the Midland Counties shall be defined as including the counties of Gloucester, except that part of South Gloucestershire which was formerly part of Avon, Hereford and Worcester, Leicester, Northampton, Rutland, Shropshire, Staffordshire, Warwick, and West Midlands.
2. The object of the Federation shall be to consider and provide means for the mutual benefit and encouragement of Federated Societies and their Members.
3. Societies making application for membership of the Federation should have been in existence for at least twelve months. Council may admit to probationary membership, Societies who have not been in existence for twelve months. In both cases the applicant Society should satisfy the Council of financial stability and the existence of a properly constituted committee. The Secretary, on behalf of the Federation, reserves the right to reject an application for membership from a society if deemed to be unsuitable for any reason. A right of appeal to the full Council is available giving at least one month's notice. The decision of the Council will be final. No further communication will be entered into.
4. The Council may recommend removal of a Member Society from membership of the Federation at the Annual General Meeting. Written reasons will be sent to the Society at least two months before the A.G.M. The Society will be given the opportunity to send a response at least one month before the A.G.M. The decision of the Meeting at the A.G.M., will be final. No further communication will be entered into.
5. The Annual Subscriptions of Societies shall be such as shall be fixed at a General Meeting. The subscription shall be payable on admission and renewable on 1st January each year, calculated on membership at previous 31st December. Any Society whose subscription is one month in arrears shall be notified by the Treasurer, and failing payment within one month of such notice, the Society shall be suspended from the Federation but it may after satisfactory explanation and payment be reinstated by the Council.
6. Each Society shall be entitled to nominate for its representation at MCPF General Meetings delegates in accordance with the following scale:

1 to 25 Members	1 Delegate
26 to 50 Members	2 Delegates
51 to 100 Members	3 Delegates
Over 100 Members	4 Delegates
- The effective date for the above scale and for calculation of subscriptions shall be the previous 31st December. Should a delegate be unable to attend a deputy may be appointed by the Society provided either the MCPF Secretary is advised in advance, or the Meeting Attendance Sheet shows who is being deputised.
7. All members of Societies may attend Federation General Meetings and Events, wherever held, but only delegates have the power to vote.
8. At a General Meeting an attendance of twenty, including council members, shall constitute a quorum and voting by proxy shall not be permitted.
9. At least seven days notice of every General Meeting, specifying the nature of the business to be transacted, shall be given to each Society and its delegates and to each member of the Council. Notwithstanding the omission to give notice of any item of business, the Chairman may, at their discretion, permit it to be transacted.
10. The Annual General Meeting at which the Secretary's report and the Treasurer's audited statement of accounts shall be presented shall be held not later than June 14th of each year.
11. A Special General Meeting of the Federation may be called at any time by the Council and the Secretary shall call a Special General Meeting on receiving a requisition, signed by the Secretaries of not less than five Societies, stating the special business to be considered. The Secretary shall advise all Societies of the holding of such Special General Meeting and shall notify them of the business to be considered, at least fifteen days before the date of the meeting.
12. The business of the Federation shall be conducted by a Council consisting of a President, a Vice-President, office holders and not more than 6 ordinary members together with such Past Presidents as have informed the secretary of their wish to continue to serve on Council.
13. All those serving on Council must be members of a federated 'club' and shall serve in an honorary capacity.
14. Council shall be elected at an Annual General Meeting and shall normally hold office for two years. In the absence of the President at a Council or General Meeting the chair shall be taken by the Vice-President or in their absence by a Past President selected at the meeting from those present.
15. In the event of it being impossible for a new President to be elected in accordance with rule 14 the outgoing President may be re-elected for a further term.
16. A person to verify the Federation's accounts shall also be elected by the AGM but shall not be a member of Council.



17. Each new candidate for election to Council shall be nominated, in writing, by two members of a club or society of the Federation, to the secretary at least twenty one days before the Annual General Meeting. The nominations shall be accompanied by an intimation from the nominee of willingness to serve, if elected, and the nomination shall be published in the agenda for the Annual General Meeting. The Secretary, on behalf of the Federation, reserves the right to reject an application for membership to Council if deemed to be unsuitable for any reason. A right of appeal to the full Council is available giving at least one month's notice. The decision of the Council will be final. No further communication will be entered into.

18. Council may fill any casual vacancies on Council subject to ratification at the next General Meeting. Council may also, subject to similar ratification, co-opt additional members to Council if needs arise. Persons joining Council in these ways will hold office until the following elections, when they may be eligible for election in the normal way.

19. Council may appoint subcommittees for special purposes who shall report to Council. All those serving on such subcommittees need not also be serving on Council but should be members of a Federated 'society'.

20. The quorum for Council meetings is five.

21. The secretary shall summon a Council meeting if requested to do so, in writing, by five Council members.

22. Those persons serving on Council are entitled to vote at all meetings of the Federation.

23. Any person serving on Council, who is absent from four consecutive meetings, Council or General, without providing an explanation acceptable to Council shall be deemed to have tendered their resignation and Council may accept such resignation.

24. Persons who have given exceptional service to the Federation may, following a recommendation by Council, with approval of an Annual General Meeting, be conferred with the title of Honorary Life Vice President. Persons receiving this honour will be entitled to attend Council meetings and receive minutes of all meetings should they so wish, but are under no obligation to render further service to the Federation.

25. In the event of the Federation being dissolved, or otherwise ceasing to exist, its property shall be transferred to the Photographic Alliance of Great Britain to be held in trust and available at the discretion of the said Alliance for any photographic Federation which may be created in the area covered by the previous Federation.

26. These rules shall not be altered except at the Annual General Meeting or at a Special General Meeting called for the purpose. Four weeks notice of a proposed alteration must be given to the Secretary, in writing.

There is an increasing amount of regulation, legislation and guidelines, which has relevance to Club/Societies. Recent examples include Portable Electrical Appliance Testing (PAT) and Risk Assessment. Failure to implement such regulations etcetera may have an adverse effect on whether or not an insurance claim will be paid. the Federation will attempt to draw the attention of its member club/societies to relevant new regulations etcetera in the Newsletter. Young and Vulnerable persons: to comply with UK legislation and child safeguarding practice, Council recommends that clubs who have not made provision for members with an appropriate CRB accreditation ensure that any young or vulnerable people attending their club are accompanied by an appropriate adult and are supervised by them at all times

MCPF Statement on Data Protection

The Midland Counties Photographic Federation (MCPF) is established with the objects set out in its governing document, and is a data controller within the UK.

The personal information referred to in this Policy may include name, contact details, service records, records of entries to events, and such other information as may be necessary for the effective management of the legitimate interests of the MCPF. Any person wishing to verify the information held by the MCPF may apply to the Secretary.

The MCPF collects and holds personal information about:

1. The executive committees of itself and of its member Clubs; others who assist those executive committees; and those offering their services to the MCPF community eg, as judges or lecturers.

This information is used to facilitate administration and services. the information is compiled into a printed handbook circulated to those named within it and to affiliated Clubs. the contact details of MCPF officials allocated to provide particular services may be published generally.

2. Others necessary for the conduct of the business of the MCPF.

This information is used to satisfy a requested service or a contractual requirement, and may be retained to confirm the outcome.

3. Photographers as the creators of Images used in the activities of the MCPF.

This information is managed subject to the General Conditions for MCPF Competition Events (qv).

The MCPF may retain historical archives for example but not limited to, records of meetings, handbooks, catalogues, awards and other event results.

Corporation Tax

Camera clubs/Photographic Societies may be liable for corporation tax on some types of fund raising activities if in total the liability exceeds £100 per annum. it is recommended that clubs seek professional advice should they consider this applies to some of their club activities.



Copyright – Reproduction – Copying – Digital Imaging - AI imaging

Please note that the following conditions apply to all MCPF Competitions and Exhibitions:

Copyright: the copyright of any entry is retained by the entrant who must be the original holder of the copyright.

Reproduction: the Federation reserves the right to reproduce any entry without fee in any publication or press or for the use of Sponsors of any event.

Copying: the Federation reserves the right to copy any entry for use in PAGB Competitions or Exhibitions.

Digital Imaging/AI: it is essential that authorship of all the original image(s) is the entrant's.

Composite Work/AI: Photographs entered must be entirely the work of the photographer and be based on images produced using a light capture technique. Composite images are permitted provided all component images meet this requirement. For the avoidance of doubt, use of images from any other source including, but not limited to, royalty free image banks, text generative AI and clip-art are not permitted.

The above conditions also apply to all PAGB Competitions and Exhibitions but should be further clarified:

Copyright: as above.

Reproduction: as above.

Copying: the PAGB reserves the right to copy accepted entries in its prints and PDI exhibitions and competitions. These copies to be circulated to the Federation thus enabling the original work to be returned to the authors. These copies to be available to the member clubs of the PAGB through the Recorded Lecture Service. From the entry to the PAGB PDI Exhibition and competition the PAGB may select any entry to any International PDI competition. The PAGB print Exhibition and Competition accepted prints and the PDI Club Championship Winners and Runner Up and Best PDI(s) are also copied to form part of the PAGB Recorded Lecture Service.

PAGB Information and Guidance

The PAGB have produced a number of documents that are available to affiliated clubs to assist with the management of their group. They are published guidance only to help clubs formulate their own policy. For further information please visit their web site—www.thepagb.org.uk. the available documents are listed on the master page.

Club Data Protection—(PAGB advice notes Feb 2018)

A Camera Club/Society will generally be a 'not-for-profit' organisation and so has an automatic exemption from the requirement to notify under the Data Protection Act 1998.

You can manage and process personal data relating to membership of your club or individuals who have regular contact with your club.

The data stored must be relevant to the relationship the individual has with your club. We advise that this information be restricted to:

Name (including any photographic awards), Date of Birth (especially if the club operates a tiered subscription) Address, Telephone Number, Email address

Competition code and relevant competition level

Any other information required for the running of your club

- You can pass on the data to other organisations such as your Federation or the PAGB providing you have the consent of the individual, usually obtained when the individual fills out a membership form.
- You are obliged to respond within 21 days to a written request from an individual to provide the information that you hold pertaining to that individual.
- You must take reasonable measures to ensure the accuracy and safe keeping of the data you maintain and process.
- You are required to delete the information concerning an individual, within a reasonable period of time, once the relationship between that individual and your club comes to an end.
- You should formally designate one or more persons to be responsible for ensuring the accuracy and safe keeping of the data held by your club.
- Clubs will need to prepare and publish a data protection policy containing an adequate description of what personal data will be collected and for what purposes.
- Clubs will need to review and document their compliance with their own policy.
- Clubs will need to inform their volunteer officials about maintaining a separation between personal data from different data controllers, and between controlled and domestic use of personal data.
- Organisers of inter-Club and similar events will need to review their entry conditions to ensure that any third party entrant confirms explicit consent for the organiser to hold personal data about the photographers entered to the event.
- Clubs must not make their membership contact information available for electronic marketing. Clubs must refuse any request to cascade marketing material to members by electronic messages.

If as a Club or Federation you distribute information to persons via electronic means, such as emails, you are required to comply with the requirements of the legislation under Regulations 22 and 23 covering Electronic Mail. It is important that you pay particular attention to the requirement that you must provide a convenient means for anyone to "opt-out" of receiving further Electronic Mail from you. The PAGB Insurance Scheme

The PAGB has negotiated insurance cover with their brokers Hive Insurance Services available to all affiliated Federations and Clubs.

Public Liability (£5million cover): Public liability insurance can cover legal costs and compensation payments if your club is held responsible for injury or property damage to a member of the public. Council considers it essential that clubs do provide adequate cover, especially for visiting judges and lecturers. The limit of Indemnity is £5M (a higher limit may be available upon request).

Property—"All Risks": this provides important cover against loss, theft or damage to club-owned or borrowed equipment.

Management protection: this provides important financial protection for the directors/officials of the club or federation against being sued in conjunction with the performance of their duties.

Clubs are free to seek alternative quotations from other brokers.

If a club does decide not to participate in the scheme(s), a declaration of responsibility must be signed by its Officers.

Definition of Black and White Photography

A black and white image fitting from the very dark grey (black) to the very clear grey (white) is a monochrome work with the various shades of grey. A black and white work toned entirely in a single colour will remain a monochrome workable to stand in the black and white category; such a work can be reproduced in black and white in the catalogue of a salon under FIAP Patronage. On the other hand a black and white image modified by a partial toning or by the addition of one colour becomes a colour work (polychrome). To stand in the colour category such a work requires colour reproduction in the catalogue of a salon under FIAP Patronage.

Definition of Nature to be used in PAGB Competitions. (May 2020)

Nature means Images where living organisms are the primary subject matter. The story telling value of an Image will normally be weighed more than the pictorial quality.

Nature includes:

- Images taken with subjects in controlled conditions such as zoos, game parks, botanic gardens, aquariums and enclosures where the subjects are dependent on man for food. Scientific bands, tags or collars are permissible.

Nature excludes:

- Images where the subjects are obviously domestic animals or plants.
Images where an obviously artistic treatment has been applied.

Processing of the captured image, by cropping, exposure adjustment, colour correction, noise minimisation, dodging/burning, HDR, focus stacking and sharpening, is permitted, as is cloning of image defects and minor distractions including overlapping elements.

An Image appearing to meet these criteria will be accepted as Nature. The Judges will normally assume that any Image presented to them is eligible.

Access to some biological subjects may be restricted. Where that is relevant, then Photographers warrant that they have followed relevant codes of practices and hold any necessary licences.



Nature – PSA/FIAP Definition

Nature photography records all branches of natural history except anthropology and archaeology. This includes all aspects of the physical world, both animate and inanimate, that have not been made or modified by humans.

Nature images must convey the truth of the scene that was photographed. A well-informed person should be able to identify the subject of the image and be satisfied that it has been presented honestly and that no unethical practices have been used to control the subject or capture the image. Images that directly or indirectly show any human activity that threatens the life or welfare of a living organism are not allowed.

The most important part of a Nature image is the nature story it tells. High technical standards are expected and the image must look natural.

Objects created by humans, and evidence of human activity, are allowed in Nature images only when they are a necessary part of the Nature story.

Photographs of human-created hybrid plants, cultivated plants, feral animals, domesticated animals, human-created hybrid animals and mounted or preserved zoological specimens are not allowed.

Images taken with subjects under controlled conditions, such as zoos, are allowed.

Controlling live subjects by chilling, anaesthetic or any other method of restricting natural movement for the purpose of a photograph is not allowed.

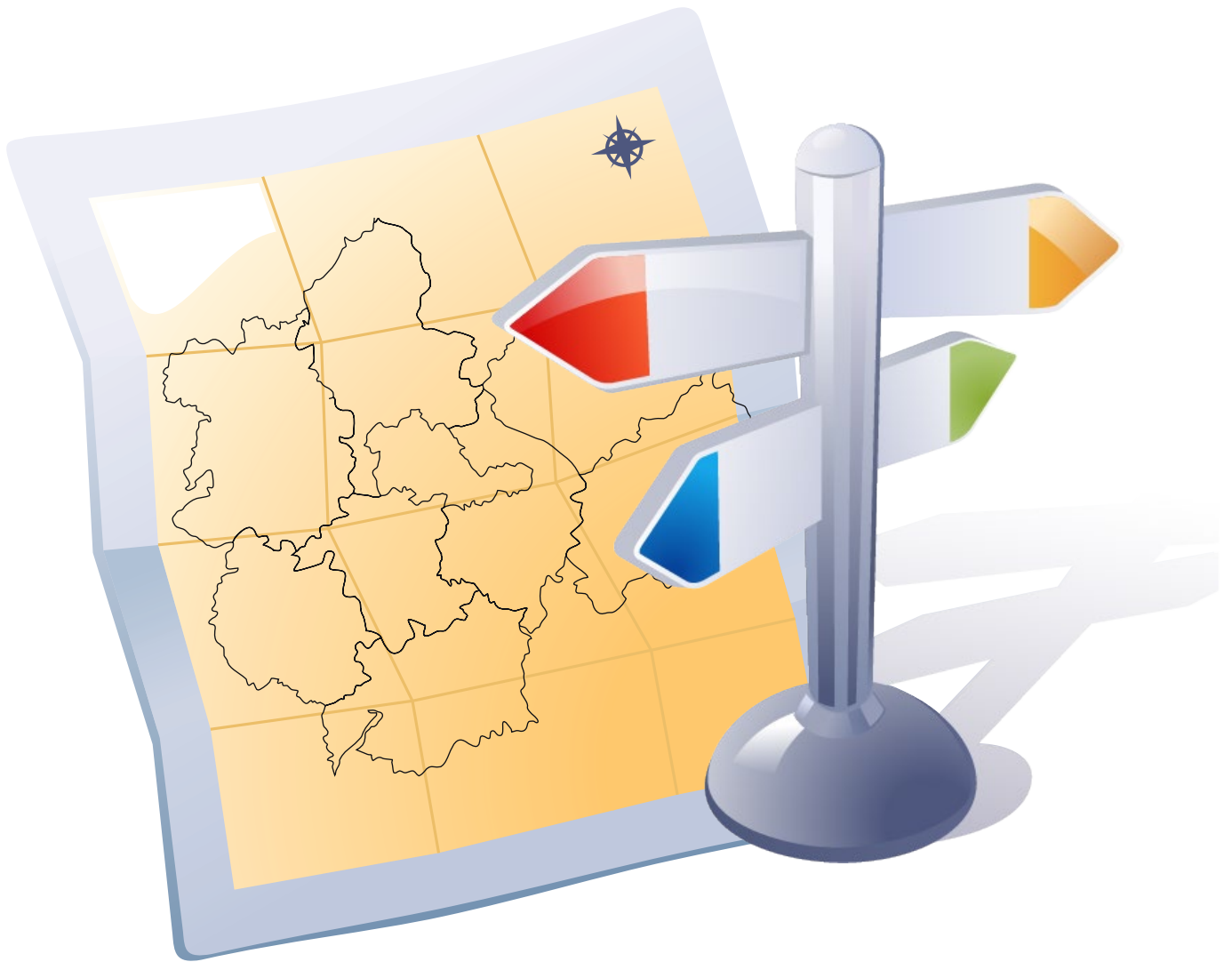
